### Ride Outs 2013

### **Eligibility and Ride Grading**

Rideouts are open to

- all members and associates of the North Wilts Group,
- RoSPA members from other groups
- invited guests of the above

This year we are trying to cater for a wider group of people by offering a mix of half day and full day rides, all taking place on the third Saturday of the month. However, if we get enough support for the rides, and volunteers to lead, we can look at running both half and full days rides in some months over the summer.

### **The Drop Off Routine**

A Briefing on the Drop-Off Routine will be held at the start of each ride. The Routine allows a group of bikes to negotiate their way efficiently together through urban and rural environments in safety without the need for members of the group (other than the LEADER) to consult a map. Details of the Routine can be found through the quick link on the front page of the website.

### **Start Points and Start Time**

The start point can vary dependent on the direction of the ride and will be chosen by the Ride Leader. The default locations are: -



North - Lorry Park Cirencester (Fuel Nearby at Tesco's)



East - Esso Garage, Chiseldon, Just off M4 Junction 15



South – New garage and coffee shop on the A346 as you leave Marlborough



West - Little Chef, North of Chippenham (Esso Garage Opposite)

Meeting time is usually 9:15 for a prompt 9:30 start but may change – can be 8:45 for a 9:00 start for a progressive ride in the summer.

#### Please arrive at the start with a full tank of fuel!

### **Further Details**

Details of the ride outs including the start point will be posted on the Forum page of the web site. If you intend to come it would be helpful, but not necessary, to add a comment so that the Ride Leader knows roughly how many people will attend. Also **PLEASE CHECK the Forum page** the night before the ride out in case of cancellation or to make sure that the start point or start time has not changed.
